The *Seminario Anual de Automática, Electrónica Industrial e Instrumentación* 2016 (SAAEI'16) will be held in this 23rd edition at the Ciutat d'Elx Congress Centre in Elche, Spain, during July 6th, 7th and 8th, 2016. This conference is organized by the Industrial Electronic Group from the University Miguel Hernández de Elche.

The SAAEI'16 will be a meeting place for researchers and experts, to exchange ideas, projects and interests in a friendly atmosphere. The Conference requests papers describing original works in the fields of Automatic, Electronics and Instrumentation.

The official languages of the Conference will be Spanish and English.

TOPIC AREAS

The main topics of the conference include, but are not limited to:

- Power conversion techniques.
- Control techniques in power converters.
- Instrumentation and measurement systems. Sensor networks.
- Devices and passive components
- Electrical energy systems, renewable energy
- Technological applications:

PAPERS

The paper should be four to six pages long and should include all the references, figures and tables needed to understand the text. It should not include any information about the authors, including self-references. The language should be Spanish or English.

The papers should be submitted through the SGE application that can be found on the web page of the conference (www.saei.org). The work has to be sent in pdf format, following the template available on the same web page. In the application form, the following data is to be included:

- Title
- Authors
- Topic area
- Presentation Preference (oral or poster).
- An abstract less than 3000 characters long.

REGISTRATION

Each registered author may send a maximum of two papers without additional charge for admission. Students will have access to a lower registration fee, which allows the submission of only one paper.

The seminar will take place at the Ciutat d'Elx Congress Centre, a modern building located in the middle of the historical palm grove, declared a World Heritage Site. The weather and good communications make Elche an ideal location for congresses and business meetings.

- The annual meeting of the Spanish Chapter of IEEE PELS-IES will be held during the conference.
- There will be a space for the participation of industrial sponsors.
